Paula Red – Mid-late August
Ginger Gold – Early September
Gala – Mid-to-late Sept. (normally ahead of McIntosh, but later than McIntosh in cool seasons)
McIntosh – Approximately Sept. 20
Honeycrisp – Late September
Cortland – Late September
Spartan – Late September/early October
Jonagold, Jonathan & Empire – Early October.
Red Delicious, Golden Delicious & Northern Spy – Mid-October.
Ida Red – Mid-late October.
Rome – Late October. (maturity may vary 1 week)
